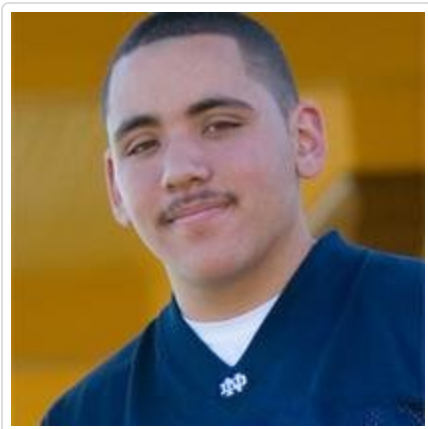




Alexander Roberts
