



## Everett Dee Spidell

April 8, 1949 - June 26, 2014

Spidell, Everett Dee, Captain U. S. Army (Ret.), passed away on June 26, 2014. He was 65 years old. Dee, as most of his friends and family knew him, was born in Corpus Christy, Texas on April 8, 1949. As the eldest son of a military family he lived all over the world, but finished high school at Highland High in Albuquerque, New Mexico in 1968. Dee attended college at the University of Guam and received several advanced degrees to enhance his career as a teacher and counselor.

His father, Everett D. Spidell, preceded him in death by just a few months. He is survived by: his loving wife, Shao Mei of Menlo Park CA; his son, Sean Spidell of Seattle, WA; his mother, Rhoda E. Spidell of Albuquerque NM.
