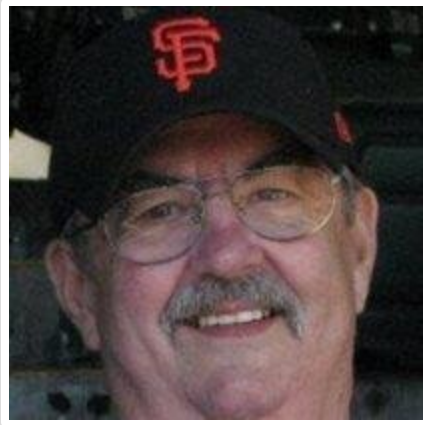




Gary Clinton Green
