Guillermo Macias was born on February 8, 1933 in Ventura, CA and entered into rest on April 21, 2016 in Palo Alto, CA at the age of 83. He is survived by his daughters Irma Serna, Michelle Macias and son Guillermo Macias Jr. He is also survived by his siblings, grandchildren and great grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents, his wife Ramona Macias, daughter Linda Casillas, and grandchildren; Robert Macias, Richard Macias and Elize Casillas.

Memo was a resident of Union City for over 65 years. He is remembered as a hard worker and a Korean War Veteran. Memo worked in the steel mill for over 20 years, then owned his own trucking business called Macias Trucking.
