Born on July 22nd, 1933 in San Gaspar de los Reyes, Jalisco, MX, and entered into rest on October 30th, 2015 in Fremont, CA at the age of 82. Survived by her daughter Maria Padilla and her son Gregorio Rodriguez Jr. of Union City, CA. Daughter of Francisco Martinez (father) and Simona Gonzalez (mother) was raised along with one brother, Pedro, and three sisters, Conception (Sor Florentina), Nemecia (Sor Gaudelia), and Mercedes.
