Oral "Obie" Boothe died peacefully on May 17, 2019 in Fremont, California. He was 41.

Oral was born on December 16, 1977 in Clarendon Jamaica to his parents Danville Boothe and Carolyn Brooks. He immigrated to the United States in 1987 and grew up on the east coast. After graduating from high school he was a "Jack of All Trades" and worked in multiple industries before discovering his true passion: food.
