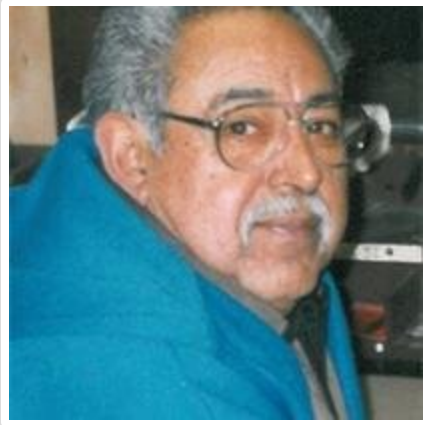




Relio Reyna

Relio Reyna was born on September 25, 1931 and passed away, surrounded by his family, on October 7, 2013. He was 82 years old.
