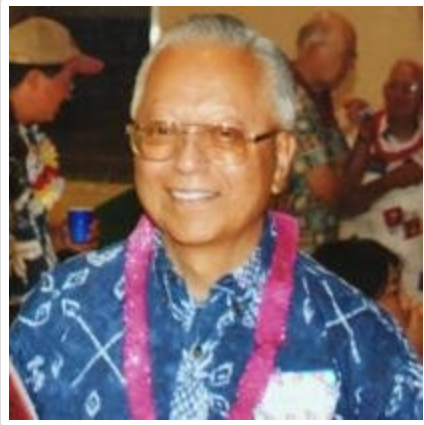




Robert Vun Yau Lee
