She enjoyed doing genealogy and her membership in the Daughters of the American Revolution (DAR). She loved to sew, complete crafts, crochet and knit, which she was usually doing while

Sharon gave up driving in 1984 and relied on public transportation. The drivers became part of her extended family, as she knew their names and all about their families. Later when Sharon began dialysis and was transported by ambulance, she took them in as extended family too.
