



Stefan Andrew Hebb

January 1, 1965 - January 27, 2015

Born January 1st, 1965 in Halifax, Nova Scotia, Canada, and entered into rest on January 27th, 2015 in Fremont, California at the age of 50. Preceded in death by his wife Janelle Hebb. Stefan was a talented artist, both visually – drawing striking photorealistic portraits – and musically - playing his guitar along with his favorite songs. He was a huge fan of Star Wars, having seen the original film dozens of times in theaters during its initial release; collecting all the toys in his youth and dressing as a Stormtrooper for his son on Halloween as an adult. His lifelong passion for trains was unparalleled, spending hours visiting

model railroad shows or watching the trains come in at the Santa Clara Depot. Stefan's greatest love in life, however, was his family. He lived each day for the last ten years of his life for his beloved son, Jeremy.
